The Grand Targhee Bluegrass Festival will celebrate its 10th year this summer with "The David Grisman Bluegrass Reunion" band. The group, formed in 1973, was originally called "Old And In The Way" but changed its name after Garcia died. In one of the Reunion's rare gigs, the remaining members - Grisman, Peter Rowan, Vassar Clements, Herb Pedersen and Jim Kerwin - will duel on Targhee's stage with original and classic bluegrass tunes. Rowan, the David Grisman Quintet and String Cheese Incident will round out the show with music from their traditional and contemporary repatoire. The scene at the Bluegrass Festival is as close to a Grateful Dead show as you will get these days, complete with a mud mosh pit, arts and crafts venders and a beer garden.
